

Lake Johanna Fire Department 2024 Annual Fire Report

In 2024 the Lake Johanna Fire Department responded to 4,866 calls for service which is an increase of 248 calls, 5.4%, from the previous year. We assisted neighboring Fire Departments a total of 120 times. We received aid 51 times in 2024.

CLOSEST UNIT DISPATCHING

All the Fire Departments in Ramsey County participate in Closest Unit Dispatching is used for specific Emergency Calls such as, Structure Fires, Cardiac Arrest calls and Water Emergencies. When one of those call types occurs, the Computer Aided Dispatch will instantly determine if there is a response unit from another agency that is closer to the incident than the host units dispatched, if so, that closest unit is added to the assigned response.


In 2024, there were 67 Closest Unit Dispatches County wide, Lake Johanna responded to six (6) incidents (four (4) Cardiac Arrests, one (1) Accident Delta call and one (1) Smoke in an Apartment building). We received aid on five (5) incidents (two (2) Cardiac Arrests, one (1) Smoke in a Dwelling, one (1) Smoke in an Apartment, and one (1) Shooting).

The City of Shoreview had a dollar loss of \$1,366,594 in 2024, higher than the previous year. The City of Arden Hills dollar loss was \$244,052, a decrease in the dollar loss from the previous year. The City of North Oaks had a dollar loss of 27,800 in 2024.

ANNUAL DOLLAR LOSS COMPARISON




Over the last 5 years the cities combined average dollar loss from Fire was \$1,761,051.

In 2024, Building fires attributed for most of the dollar loss totaling about \$1,469,450. The next highest loss total was from Vehicle fires which totaled \$128,100.

THE DEPARTMENT RESPONSE

On Duty Shift crews handled 98.8% of the calls responding to 4,807 calls in 2024. Stations were called back to assist the Shift Crews 59 times throughout the year, which is roughly 1.21% of the calls.

STAFFING CHANGES IMPLEMENTED

In February, the Department hired six (6) full-time Captains who are assigned to work 24-hour shifts out of Station 120 and Station 140. Adding two Captains on duty allowed us to redistribute the six part-time positions in late February to begin staffing Station 130 with a crew of two firefighters. When all positions on a shift are filled, we have three on duty at Station 120, two on duty at Station 130, and three on duty at Station 140. Having a third station staffed has improved our response times across all three cities. It also drastically reduced the number of times we needed to call back off duty personnel to staff the stations.




3-year Comparison Response Time in Minutes






CALLS BY MONTH




CALLS BY TIME OF DAY




CALLS BY DAY OF WEEK

(100 Series – Fire) FIRE DOLLAR LOSS BY MONTH


